



Are you a not-for-profit organisation in or near Lyme Regis providing recreational activities?

If so, you may be eligible to apply for capital funding for projects related to the arts, sports, museums and play equipment

West Dorset District Council has £102,300.13 of Section 106 funding available for capital projects and is working with Lyme Regis Town Council to allocate the money to eligible projects

The funding falls into seven categories: public open space; parks, gardens and outdoor sport; play areas; allotments; amenity space; natural greenspace; and community venues

Funding is available for organisations based in or near Lyme Regis, for equipment and buildings, but not for revenue funding, events, seminars, workshops, or repairs and maintenance works

Lyme Regis Town Council has arranged an open meeting on **Wednesday 4 July at 7pm in the Guildhall, Lyme Regis** for local organisations to find out more, check eligibility, and discuss potential projects
